Roll Call: Chairman Robert Faugh called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Present: Commissioners Robert Faugh, Michael Terzo (7:25 pm), Lawrence Meston, Dale Sweet, Scott Goodman, Treasurer Robert Kuhls, and Secretary Colleen Statskey.

Representing the Rush Fire Department was Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. and Firefighter Andrew Socola.

Representing the Town of Rush was Councilman Gerry Kusse

Absent: Chief James McNeil and Assistant Chief Jon Faugh.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN: Councilman Kusse spoke regarding the Dorschel property that is for sale. Reports being heard were The Dorschel owner struggled too long with the property being converted from R-30 to Commercial.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The Minutes of January 17, 2017, were approved.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lawrence Meston, seconded by Commissioner Dale Sweet and approved 5-0 to accept the Minutes of January 17, 2017, as written.

AREAS OF CONCERN:

COMMUNICATIONS: None.

FIRE MARSHAL: Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. and Commissioner Robert Faugh reported property at 440 Five Points Road difficulty getting 584 down the driveway. Fire Marshal Tracy to contact the home owner.

NEW EQUIPMENT: Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. reported EMS bags have been ordered for the Chiefs and the DO to match the ambulance. The goal is to have all vehicles with the same EMS bags. A drill is scheduled for March 20th to review them. Assistant Mike Terzo, Jr. thanked Jenna Cirincione for all of her hard work with the EMS bags. Jenna also had Henrietta Ambulance donate one EMS bag to replace the Duty Officers bag.

Five Wild land search bags, cost estimated at \$100.00 a bag, have been put together. Each bag will contain basic first aid supplies as well as bug spray, cliff bars, hand warmers and glow sticks. Three expired 150 FT ropes will need to be replaced.

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New gear has been ordered for Kyle McNeil, old gear has two cuts on the outer shell from two previous fires. Low Band Mobiles and Portables were donated to the Town of Rush Highway Department.

Commissioner Robert Faugh reported when 584 was delivered it had a 50' 2.5" yellow hose that was not good, 584 is missing the 50' yellow hose. Commissioner Michael Terzo will contact Churchville regarding the hose.

TRAINING: Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. reported a six month training schedule has been sent out to all. Ice Rescue is scheduled for February 22nd with Honeoye Falls, Scottsville, Henrietta and Chili. More joint drills have been scheduled with Honeoye Falls and Henrietta. Marisa Scott is taking EMT with Henrietta Ambulance. Commissioner Dale Sweet, Abby O'Neill, Diana Pfersock, Royer Pfersick, Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. are refreshing their EMT's. Tim Relyea is taking building construction classes and Safety Officer class. Tim is also working to obtain his NYS Safety Officer certification. Eric McNeil, Chief James McNeil, Jim Princehorn, and Will Stanton are attending Awareness classes. We will ensure that Kyle McNeil, Patrick Frediani and Tim Relyea attend Fire Officer 1 Class. FIT Testing is complete. Cathy Henry has an appointment with the Fire Bureau. Mandatory training is in progress and requested the need for make up classes. Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. reported Commissioner Michael Terzo and Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. would like to attend the Tech Rescue Conference on March 30th through April 2, 2017. They would like to have a couple Firefighters/Officers attend also.

Commissioner Robert Faugh reported that the Commissioner's Training Class Certification is on file. Commissioner Robert Faugh requested one folder with all of the Commissioner's Training Certificates. Secretary Colleen Statskey to maintain the file.

HOUSE #1: Commissioner Lawrence Meston contacted Syracuse to replace the panels on the pumps with no response. Commissioner Lawrence Meston has received a quote from VP Supply for \$700.00 and Ground Water Systems for \$900.00. Commissioner Lawrence Meston is checking on the electrical wires and the job is in progress. Commissioner Dale Sweet cleaned out the backroom with the workbench. Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. reported the Bullhorn fell off the tray and broke. Commissioner Robert Faugh reported abj Protection worked on the sprinkler deficiencies and the job is complete for House #1 and House #2. Commissioner Michael Terzo replaced the light bulbs.

HOUSE #2: Commissioner Robert Faugh reported the sprinkler system deficiencies are completed. Commissioner Lawrence Meston stated the generator is up and running. Commissioner Lawrence Meston spoke with Bruce O'Neill to remove the Ash, Locust and Maples trees that surround the siren. Green Ash by the parking lot needs to be removed. Commissioner Lawrence Meston spoke with the landscaper and Bruce O'Neill about landscaping the garden along the side and the bushes. Quotes are being obtained. Commissioner Lawrence Meston will contact RG&E to raise the gas meter.

VEHICLE & EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE: Commissioner Robert Faugh reported 583 new LED flood lights installed. HarRob could not get them to work after 4 hours

of work and gave a quote to rebuild 12 Volt to 110 Volt inverter for \$1600.00 and \$630.00 to install. Assistant Chief Jon Faugh and Commissioner Robert Faugh removed the inverter that was broke and installed a 12 Volt to 110 Volt 1000 watt 10 AMP inverter from Home Deport for \$99.00 and the LED flood lights work fine.

Commissioner Robert Faugh indicated 583 low water light/buzzer shuts off when the truck has warmed up. Commissioner Dale Sweet changed the intake strainers on 582 and 583. Commissioner Robert Faugh reported the New Officers are doing a great job checking the trucks. Commissioner Dale Sweet reported Sean Brown, Patrick Frediani, Marisa Sweet, Tyler Grillo and Eric McNeil cleaned the inside, outside and waxed 582. The Brush Truck has been cleaned also.

Commissioner Michael Terzo repaired the electric box on cord reel on 582.

SAFETY/OSHA: Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. stated Safety Officer Tim Relyea has been busy taking Safety Officer classes.

PHYSICALS: Commissioner Lawrence Meston stated that Healthworks will perform firefighter physicals on Monday, February 27th. Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr., wanted to confirm when Explorers are voted into the Fire Department as a Firefighter they are required to have a physical before they can ride the trucks.

PHYSICAL FITNESS: Commissioner Dale Sweet will put together a policy for the Physical Fitness Stipend reimbursement. The Physical Fitness Stipend reimbursement was discussed and reviewed by the Fire Commissioners.

EMS, **911**, **STREET DIRECTORY**: Commissioner Robert Faugh discussed the rebroadcasting. Commissioner Michael Terzo will contact 911 regarding the rebroadcasting. Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr., reported Henrietta will now be sending Quint 640 and the closest Career engine for any Struct A calls instead of waiting for the engine to get back and move manpower to the Quint. Looking into updating box book system and removing West Brighton. Commissioner Scott Goodman reported no EMS concerns at this time.

INVENTORY, INSPECTION & INSPECTION DINNER: The 583 12 Volt to 110 Volt inverter has a separate inventory ID tag.

LEGISLATION: None.

INSURANCE AND GROUP LIFE INSURANCE: Treasurer Robert Kuhls reported no changes.

MEMBERSHIP: Assistant Chief Mike Terzo, Jr. stated Brent Argauer gear has been turned in. Waiting for official paperwork from the Fire Department Secretary.
