**Roll Call:** Chairman Robert Faugh called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN: Councilwoman Coffey reported the Finance audit is complete. The shutters will be installed on the Town Hall. Upgrade to the Highway Lighting to LED with a 3 ½ year payback. A presentation by Bruce Howlett, Howlett Farms, made recommendations and land improvements to the Rush Riverside Refuge. At the next board meeting a decision should be made. A decision was made the dissolve the Biondo Court Park District and was passed. The funds will be transferred to the Parks and Recreation Reserve Fund. Rush Associates project waiting for final Environmental Impact Study in review by the town engineer. Engineering report for the buildings at the BOCES property was received and reviewed by the board and based on their recommendations a small garage was torn down.
