Jason Schwartz, Bernard Donegan, Inc. reviewed the 2018 Proposed Fire District Budget.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN: Councilman Gerry Kusse discussed the past flooding issue in the Rush Hamlet in July, 2017 and the Monroe County Fair.

FIRE MARSHAL: No Report.

NEW EQUIPMENT: Commissioner Robert Faugh reported the Rush Fire Department wrote a check out for half of the helmet cost to the Rush Fire District.
