Roll Call: Chairman Scott Goodman called the virtual meeting (recorded) to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Present: Commissioners Scott Goodman, Robert Faugh, Michael Terzo, Dale Sweet, Doug Platt (technical difficulties), Treasurer Robert Kuhls and Secretary Colleen Statskey.

Representing the Rush Fire Department was Chief Jon Faugh and Assistant Chief Kevin Smith.

Representing the Town of Rush was Councilman Dan Woolaver.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN: Councilman Dan Woolaver notified the Commissioners of the solar battery moratorium to be held.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The Minutes of March 17, 2020, were approved as written.

A motion was made by Commissioner Michael Terzo, seconded by Commissioner Dale Sweet and approved 4-0 to accept the Minutes of March 17, 2020, as written.

COMMUNICATIONS: None.

FIRE MARSHAL: (Chief Jon Faugh excused himself to go to an emergency call). Chief Jon Faugh returned from the call and reported communications with Fire Marshal are done on a routine basis and there are no concerns.

Commissioner Michael Terzo will obtain new separate master keys for the District Office, Chief Office and President Office. Commissioner Dale Sweet replaced the hoses on the back of the truck bay reels. Commissioner Scott Goodman stated that Commissioner Doug Platt reported the circuits on 589 and 588 were tripped. The circuit was reset. Commissioner Robert Faugh has been cleaning House #1 due to the Heritage Christian Home residents that have not been present due to COVID-19 restrictions. Commissioner Robert Faugh returned the cans and bottles. Treasurer Robert Kuhls reported the kitchen light is always left on during the day.

HOUSE #2: Commissioner Dale Sweet reported a work detail cleanup is needed as soon as COVID-19 restrictions are lifted.

INSURANCE AND GROUP LIFE INSURANCE: Treasurer Robert Kuhls stated no changes were made. Treasurer Robert Kuhls reported NYS Safety Group 497 Fleury Risk Management, (VFBL and Workmens Comp.) are declaring a 35% dividend for the year 2018-2019 policy. Treasurer Robert Kuhls received a letter dated March 6, 2020, stating the Group Life Insurance policy will be terminated due to Security Mutual Life will no longer be offering VESO Life coverage as of June 1, 2020. Commissioner Dale Sweet reported no cancellation notices have been received. At next month meeting a new policy will need to be chosen. Commissioner Dale Sweet is obtaining quotes from Gary Wilkins from two different companies and McNeil & Company, Inc.

All three quotes will be obtained: 1) \$25,000 with a limit at a specific age 2) \$25,000 with no age limits 3) \$50,000 with no age limits.
