Roll Call: Chairman Scott Goodman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

REPORT FROM THE TOWN: Councilman Dan Woolaver asked the Commissioners if they had any concerns with beer being served at the County Fair. The Fire Commissioners have no concerns with this. Commissioner Scott Goodman will prepare a report for the next Fire Commissioners Meeting regarding large scale Lithium Ion batteries to discuss with Councilman Dan Woolaver. TRAINING: Second Assistant Chief Kevin Smith reported a great turnout at last night training. Proper precautions were used pertaining to COVID-19.

HOUSE #1: Commissioner Robert Faugh reported in the old section of the men's bathroom the toilet was running. The batteries need to be replaced. Commissioner

Michael Terzo reported Pipetone did the annual service for spring. Commissioner Dale Sweet stated the septic system alarm was on. The pump was running and the tank was full of water. The system was repaired. Larry Kaplan would like to run new wires out to the septic system.

HOUSE #2: (1st Assistant Chief Sean Brown arrived) Commissioner Dale Sweet stated a major work detail will need to be done after the fire truck is completed.

VEHICLE & EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE: Commissioner Michael Terzo reported Har-Rob repaired the override valve on 588, replaced the screws on the driver's side of the vehicle. Commissioner Michael Terzo reported Har-Rob replaced 582 air switch for the air horn. The control box for the siren is going to be \$1800.00.

INSURANCE AND GROUP LIFE INSURANCE: Treasurer Robert Kuhls reported no changes. Commissioner Dale Sweet obtained 4 quotes for \$25,000 coverage with no restrictions on age. Glatfelter Insurance Group Policy through Gary Wilkins is the best price with a guarantee.

A motion made by Commissioner Dale Sweet, seconded by Commissioner Doug Platt, and approved 5 to 0, to accept the new life insurance policy with Glatfelter Insurance Group through Gary Wilkins.

Commissioner Dale Sweet reached out several times to VESCO Life Insurance to obtain quotes. The representative never returned any information that was requested or indicated that the policy was going to be canceled by June 1, 2020.
