Roll Call: Chairman Scott Goodman called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Present: Chairman Scott Goodman, Commissioners Robert Faugh, Michael Terzo, Dale Sweet, Treasurer Aletha Steehler, Secretary Kitty Stappenbeck.

Absent: Commissioner Doug Platt

Representing the Rush Fire Department: Chief Jonathan Faugh, 1st Assistant Chief Sean Brown, Jim Princehorn

Representing the Town of Rush: Councilman Dan Woolever

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Mike Terzo, seconded by Commissioner Dale Sweet and approved 4-0 to accept the Minutes of June 15, 2021 as submitted.

Town Councilman Dan Woolever brought up the reassessment of Rush property tax rate (up 28%) and raised a concern about the Rush Fire District keeping their rate the same as last year when planning their budget.

Dates of carnival were confirmed – August 20-21: live music, food, beer, no rides.

AREAS OF CONCERN:

FIRE MARSHAL: Chief Jonathan Faugh indicated no concerns at this time.

TRAINING: First Assistant Chief Sean Brown reported that 2nd Assistant Chief Kevin Smith said everyone is up to date.

- Lauren started firefighter 1, Luke Keyes, Claudia McDaniel finished.
- Will try to get Sean into training soon.
- New program train the trainer
- Firefighter 1 class Oct 16 8 -11 am; fire department will send engine and firefighters.
- Firefighter 1 class Oct 25 will send engine and firefighters.
- Commissioner Mike Terzo had questions for the Training Chief who was not present. Who is going to sign up for surface water training classes?
- Fire bureau not offering classes because of lack of instructors.

NEW EQUIPMENT: Commissioner Mike Terzo reported:

- Commissioner Mike Terzo and Mike Terzo Jr. attended vendor show:
 - Disappointment conveyed around offerings. Brief discussion among commissioners around new equipment available
- Special on foam Commissioner Mike Terzo will get price on 4 pails
- Docking station on 584 is damaged and new one cannot be obtained
- Ordered boots for fire fighters

HOUSE #1: Commissioner Mike Terzo reported:

- Air conditioner cleaned by Pipitone
- Septic system alarm went off, Commissioner Sweet checked it out, but it seemed to be working ok
 - Commissioner Dale Sweet reported he can't find anything wrong
 - Larry Kaplan (licensed electrician) is willing to change out wires and put light on side of fire house. Needs to schedule time.
- All key locks are replaced now and are inactive except: front door, commissioner office, small multipurpose room.
 - 1st Assistant Chief Sean Brown requested access to commissioner office be added to his key fob (for copier use)
- Discussion regarding new phone system Commissioner Scott Goodman will research 3rd party to manage phone system

HOUSE #2:

Parts for engine 9 – Chief Jonathan Faugh is working on

VEHICLE EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE: Commissioner Mike Terzo reported:

- Rear 584 on board kussmaul air compressor motor getting hot Commissioner Mike Terzo will get it serviced
- Boat checked oil and motor, needed new oil, purchased.
 - Also ordered another charger for portable lights on boat. Equipment check sheet indicated boat was checked once in May and once in June – but no one is keeping boat topped off, so oil was low
- 583 pump has not been run, pump is dead (since Jan). Should run each week for about 20 minutes to keep it charged
 - Check interstate to see about new battery
- Ambulance recently checked by Jenna, but is not being done regularly

Commissioner Scott Goodman indicated that DO Andrew Socola is not doing his job – he will not be doing next year

INVENTORY, INSPECTION & INSPECTION DINNER:

• Commissioners agreed that there should be a dinner this year:

- Commissioner Mike Terzo indicated to secretary that gear sheets should be printed out for each firefighter
 - Letter to each firefighters goes out in September with inspection held in October

MCFDOA:

Annual dinner meeting attended by Commissioner Scott Goodman, Commissioner Doug Platt, Treasurer Aletha Steehler and Secretary Kitty Stappenbeck. Educational talk was on the new marijuana laws. Take away: Fire Department/District should have a written policy.

PUBLICITY:

Commissioner Bob Faugh indicated that Chief Jonathan Faugh got the department some good publicity on Spectrum News regarding fireworks

PHYSICALS:

- Commissioner Dale Sweet has had his physical and his form is in Secretary tray to be filed
- Chief Jonathan Faught indicated that Will Stanton said he didn't get his physical done because he was going to resign; he has now changed his mind and will not resign.

OFFICE EQUIPMENT: Secretary Kitty Stappenbeck reported that the office copier has been serviced, cleaned, and toner cartridges replenished.

INSURANCE AND GROUP LIFE INSURANCE: Commissioner Dale Sweet reported:

- \$5000 coverage for each 'helper' for carnival, etc. If not enough can raise amount.
 - o Commissioner Sweet will check to see what increase will cost.

- Drivers' license check only 1 response, has been checked and cleared to drive.

LEGISLATION:

Discussion regarding Air Packs and number of oxygen bottles on hand. It may be determined that we have more than enough and don't need to fill all empties.

Commissioner Dale Sweet reported that the counter in the kitchen is able to be repaired.

Contractor looked at it and indicated he can fix to the satisfaction of the Ladies Auxiliary.

Motion made by Commissioner Mike Terzo, seconded by Commissioner Bob Faugh to repair kitchen countertop. Passed 4 – 0.

Commissioner Scott Goodman reported he attended an ambulance call: response time was unacceptable. Call came in at 10:24, rebroadcast at 10:28 – none available in Henrietta. Commissioner Goodman enroute at 10:36, arrived at scene in 2 minutes. Commissioner Goodman wants to hire a full-time person that would serve as a multifunction position: firefighter, EMT, administrator. He will forward written plan to the board.

 training available that they can take advantage of.

 to approve. Passed 4 0.

 Motion made by Commissioner Dale Sweet and seconded by Commissioner Mike Terzo to approve the August event. Passed 4 0.

Commissioner Dale Sweet made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mike Terzo and approved 4 to 0 to close the meeting. It was adjourned by common consent at 9:41 PM.
